The board directed Attorney Schricker to prepare the tax levy in the amount of \$150,500, which is just under the 5% allowed without having to hold a truth-in-taxation hearing.

Chief Lally discussed his request to use the unmarked as a take-home vehicle. He has responded to a couple of calls when he was on his way home after a shift, one which resulted in an arrest. Without a squad, he could not transport, nor could he provide video. His request to install lights in his personal vehicle had been discussed previously. Attorney Schricker will check again about the liability with this solution and this item will be carried over to next month.

The committee meetings were called to order. They were held at Village Hall.

Street

• The trucks are ready for the winter weather.

Water

• The committee will recommend approval of the annual inspection agreement for the cathodic protection at the water tower for 2023 in the amount of \$750 (up from \$735 last year).

Sewer

- There is a problem with the float at the wet wells that is being looked into. The alarm is not going off when it should.
- Some sewer cleaning needs done in the area of the school. Weather allowing, this will be done after the first of the year.

Park & Community Events

- The committee discussed having a decorating contest in the park for next Christmas. Groups/families could select an area of the park to decorate for the holidays. Possibly include an entry fee that would then be given back for the top 3 best decorated areas. Each entry would be responsible for their area to put up, take down, and store.
- Stefanie asked if costs for operating the splash pad this summer have been determined. No substantial increase was seen in electric costs. Water use for the four months were calculated to be approximately \$4,500.

Finance, Administration & Development

- The committee will recommend approval of the Tazewell County Animal Control contract for 2023 in the amount of \$752.52.
- The attorney will have the tax levy ordinance prepared and ready for adoption at tomorrow's regular village board meeting.

Police

• The committee discussed Chief Lally taking home a squad. The attorney will be asked for his opinion on liability. Questions including why calls are being answered after hours. Do they

- need to be? Chief Lally stated that he has responded to calls after hours on his way home. The squad be driven to the college and then to the village. Conversation will continue tomorrow, and a decision should be made at this time.
- Chief Lally reported that he seized a vehicle in a drug arrest. It will be sold at auction by the state and the village will receive 65% of the sale proceeds.
- Chief Lally reported he had a fender bender in the new '17 squad at the jail in Eureka. Insurance has been notified and an insurance claim has been opened.

There being no further business to discuss, these meetings were adjourned.
